The UMass Turf Pathology Lab's snow mold trials are used for testing new and commonly used snow mold fungicides/bio products against native populations of pink snow mold (*Microdochium nivale*) and Typhula blight (*Typhula* spp.).

These field days provide an opportunity to see first-hand the results of the latest snow mold trials.

This is the final year for the snowmold research. Along with the snowmold fungicide research and field trial plots, they will be discussing, SDHI fungicide resistance was recently discovered and management implications will be reviewed.
